

HIGH SCHOOL TOURNAMENT RULES

1a) These tournaments are for teams made up with players from the same school with the (option) of 2 players from another high school if you are short players. With IHSAA eligibility remaining in the 2011-2012 school year.

1b) A team waiver must be signed by a parent or a guardian before participation. Team rosters must be turned in before game time with names and grades, if using players from other high schools please identify the name and school.

2) All IHSAA rules will apply, including coach rules!

3) All players must be in the same color uniforms with a number on the back.

4) Time considerations:

★ Line up card must be turned into the home / plate umpire.

Game time is forfeit time.

Time limit will be one hour and 30 minutes on pool play, no time limit on single elimination.

★ Courtesy runner must be used for catcher with 2 outs, using a sub first, if no sub runner must be last out, if pitcher is last out, use the next recorded out.

★ Pitchers are allowed 5 warm-ups at the start, then 1 per inning.

★ No infield or outfield balls after first inning.

★ After 7 innings, the international tiebreaker rule will apply.

★ Any games interrupted by rain will continue at the point of interruption.

★ No batted infield practice will be allowed (ground balls in foul territory and fly balls in half of outfield is permissible).

5) Final standings will be determined by win-loss record with ties broken in order the following: A. Head to Head B. Fewest runs allowed C. Runs scored-Runs Difference

6) Some parks are smoke free. Please obey the park signs and inform parents.

7) There will be a gate charge for spectator admission. Players and (3) coaches are admitted free. Children under 12 free.

8) A full concession stand will be located in the center of complexes. Team coolers only with water are allowed.

No grills are allowed. There are designated food areas.
